PROCEDURE FOR INSTALLATION OF SERVICE LINE AND MAIN TAPS

- Contractor and Owner are solely responsible for identifying, obtaining and completing all applications/permits/approvals/inspections required by other agencies.
- Mark-out of MUA and other utilities must be obtained through the NJ One Call (811) in accordance with State requirements prior to the start of the proposed work. Other utilities must be contacted directly to schedule mark outs. Be advised that mark out of MUA utilities is based on information supplied by others, not obtained by Authority Personnel. Water and sewer mark outs should be considered approximate.
- A Pre-construction meeting must be scheduled with the Authority Engineering Dept. after all of the
 utilities have been marked out. At least 48 hours' notice is needed in order to schedule the manpower.
 Main/utility locations, standard construction details, approved site utility layout, and emergency
 procedures are some of the topics that will be reviewed at the meeting. The contractor will also be
 advised of any other requirements or procedures.
- The proposed start of construction date must be approved by the Authority. Consideration will be given to
 personnel scheduling and operational issues. At least 48 hours' notice is required for review/approval. To
 expedite this process, it is recommended that you provide more than one start date for MUA
 consideration
- After construction commences the contractor is advised that Authority Engineering Dept. will, without exception, have sole authority to make decisions regarding the work in progress if and when this work adversely affects the MUA system, operations, personnel, customers or the health, safety or welfare of the contractor employees or others. Contractors completing work contrary to MUA direction shall be required to immediately correct the deficient work and/or shall not be permitted in the future to complete work on water or sewer facilities within our franchise area. The Authority reserves the right to take other action if appropriate, to resolve the issue.
- All work in the Public right-of-way or easements dedicated to the MUA must be approved by either the MUA's consulting engineer or Authority personnel before the line is put into service.
- The Customer must verify completion of the work to the Authority prior to the work being formally approved by the Authority thru issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy/Approval.

5. Obtain and review the current <i>Mount Laurel Township MUA Rules, Regulations and Standard Construction Details</i> located at www.MLTMUA.com as it applies to applications fees, coordination, construction, inspection, final approval process or is otherwise associated with the proposed construction.
6. Submit plan for connection including location of service lines, laterals, curb stops, clean outs, location of connection to the main and the meter location. Submit material cuts of all material/equipment to be used.
7. Obtain utility mark-out NJ One Call (811)
8. Schedule and attend an on-site Pre-Construction meeting with the appropriate MUA department(s) to obtain MUA approval to commence construction. Forty-eight (48) hours advance notice is required. Call the Engineering Department/Inspector at 856-722-5900 x115
9. Before leaving Pre-Construction meeting, obtain approved S4/W4 Application to commence sewer and/or water construction, along with an approved Building Permit Release for submittal to Mt Laurel Township Construction Office.
10. Complete work in conformance with all Authority Rules, Regulations and Standard Details and obtain MUA approval of construction completed. Correct any deficiencies prior to MUA approval for service.
11. Provide asbuilt drawings locating all of the installed items shown on the approved plan.
Owner: 12. Requests acceptance as MUA customer and, if applicable, schedules installation of a meter by MUA. (Customer billing commences)
13. Request and obtain a signed MUA Certificate of Occupancy Release Form prior to submittal to Mount Laurel Township for a Certificate of Occupancy or Certificate of Approval.
14. After acceptance as an MUA customer, and installation of meter for service connections, the owner is authorized to use the new service.

- a. TRACER WIRE SHALL BE MINIMUM #10 AWG COPPER WIRE COATED WITH A MINIMUM 30 MIL POLYETHYLENE JACKET DESIGNED SPECIFICALLY FOR BURIED USE.
- b. Tracer wire should be installed continuously along the PIPE route with access points placed every 500 feet or at termination of any section of PIPE or connection to any existing main or other structure. The tracer wire shall be brought to the ground surface at access points, see tracer wire access point detail. The tracer wire shall be connected to the tracer wire box lid as recommended by the manufacturer. Splices in the tracer wire should be connected by the manufacturer splices in the tracer wire should be connected by means of a heat shrink splice kit to ensure continuity. Wire notes should not be used.
- c. AFTER INSTALLATION, TRACER WIRE SHOULD BE TESTED TO VERIFY CONTINUITY OF THE TRACER WIRE SYSTEM AND A REPORT INDICATING CONTINUITY SHOULD BE SUBMITTED AS PART OF THE AS-BUILT CONSTRUCTION RECORDS.
- d. TRACER WIRE SHALL BE PLACED ON THE TOP SIDE OF THE PIPE. WIRE SHALL BE ATTACHED TO THE PIPE USING NYLON CABLE TIES SPACED AT TEN FOOT (10') INTERVALS.

SANITARY SEWER LATERALS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED OF PVC CONFORMING TO ASTM D-3034, SDR-35 FROM THE SANITARY SEWER MAIN TO THE CLEANOUT JUST BEHIND THE CURB LINE, AND FOUR-INCH (4") OR SIX-INCH (6") PIPE FROM THE CURB LINE TO THE HOUSE. ALL JOINTS SHALL BE PUSH-ON CONFORMING TO ASTM D-3212 WITH ELASTOMETRIC RING RUBBER GASKETS CONFORMING TO ASTM D-3212.
- WHERE A PLUG IS PROVIDED ON RISER CLEANOUT, IT SHALL CONTAIN MAGNETIC MATERIAL SO THAT IT MAY BE LOCATED WITH A METAL DETECTOR.
- CLEANOUTS SHALL NOT BE LOCATED IN SIDEWALKS OR DRIVEWAYS. IN NO CASE SHALL SANITARY SEWER LATERALS BE INSTALLED UNDER DRIVEWAYS.
- 4. SANITARY SEWER LATERALS SHALL BE INSTALLED AT A CONSTANT GRADE AND IN A STRAIGHT LINE. CLEANOUTS ARE REQUIRED EVERY 50' AND AT ANY CHANGE IN DIRECTION OF THE LATERAL.
- 5. THE MINIMUM DEPTH FOR A SANITARY SEWER LATERAL SHALL BE THIRTY—SIX INCHES (36").
- 6. TRACER WIRE IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PVC, HDPE OR NON-METALLIC LATERALS AND MUST BE INSTALLED ALL THE WAY TO THE BUILDING, TO ENABLE DETECTION BY A RADIO FREQUENCY CABLE AND PIPE LOCATOR. SEE TRACER WIRE NOTES FOR SPECIFICATIONS.

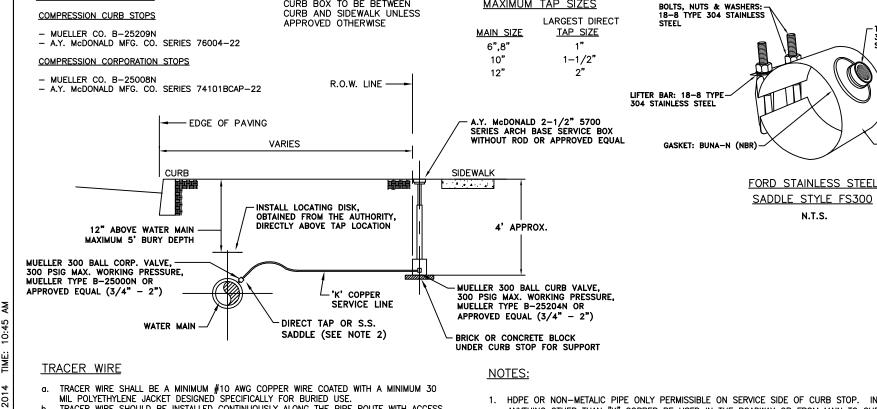

CURB BOX TO BE BETWEEN

- TRACER WIRE SHOULD BE INSTALLED CONTINUOUSLY ALONG THE PIPE ROUTE WITH ACCESS POINT PLACED EVERY 500 FEET OR AT TERMINATION OF ANY SECTION OF PIPE OR CONNECTION TO ANY EXISTING MAIN OR OTHER STRUCTURE. THE TRACER WIRE SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE GROUND SURFACE AT ACCESS POINTS, SEE TRACER WIRE ACCESS POINT DETAIL. THE TRACER WIRE SHALL BE CONNECTED TO THE TRACER WIRE BOX LID AS RECOMMENDED BY THE MANUFACTURER. SPLICES IN THE TRACER WIRE SHOULD BE CONNECTED BY MEANS OF A HEAT SHRINK SPLICE KIT TO ENSURE CONTINUITY. WIRE NUTS SHOULD NOT BE USED.
- AFTER INSTALLATION, TRACER WIRE SHOULD BE TESTED TO VERIFY CONTINUITY OF THE TRACER WIRE SYSTEM AND A REPORT INDICATING CONTINUITY SHOULD BE SUBMITTED AS PART OF THE AS-BUILT CONSTRUCTION RECORDS.
- d. TRACER WIRE SHALL BE PLACED ON THE TOP SIDE OF THE PIPE. WIRE SHALL BE ATTACHED TO THE PIPE USING NYLON CABLE TIES SPACED AT TEN FOOT (10') INTERVALS.

- 1. HDPE OR NON-METALIC PIPE ONLY PERMISSIBLE ON SERVICE SIDE OF CURB STOP. IN NO CASE SHALL ANYTHING OTHER THAN "K" COPPER BE USED IN THE ROADWAY OR FROM MAIN TO CURB STOP.
- HDPE SHALL BE DR-11, PE4710 (200 PSI).
- TRACER WIRE SHALL BE INSTALLED FOR ALL HDPE OR NON-METALIC PIPE AND MUST BE INSTALLED ALL THE WAY TO THE BUILDING, TO ENABLE DETECTION BE A RADIO FREQUENCY CABLE AND PIPE LOCATOR. SEE TRACER WIRE NOTES FOR SPECIFICATIONS.
- 4. STAINLESS STEEL TAPPING SADDLES MUST BE USED FOR:
 - A) ACP OR PVC PIPE.

- B) IN AN INSTANCE WHERE TAP IS TO BE LARGER THAN MAXIMUM TAP SIZE FOR THE MAIN.
- 5. FOR INSTANCES WHERE A TAPPING SADDLE IS USED, TAPPING SADDLES MUST CONTAIN 100% STAINLESS STEEL PARTS AND BE RATED FOR 250 PSI MINIMUM WORKING PRESSURE, SUCH AS FORD STAINLESS STEEL STYLE FS300 OR APPROVED EQUAL AND MUST BE APPROVED PRIOR TO USE.

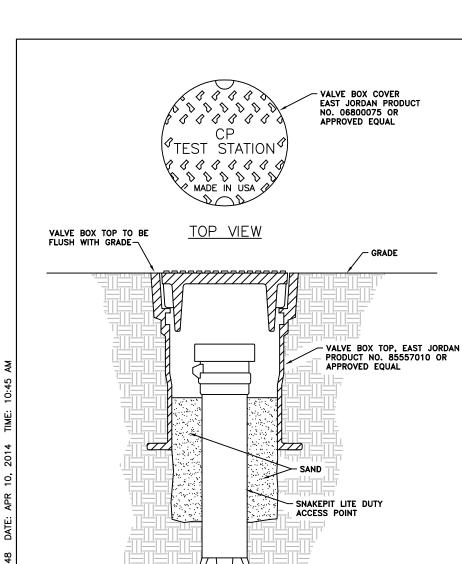
